

VINYL FLOORS – MAINTENANCE

How to clean vinyl floors?

Additionally, painting over a vinyl roll flooring could lead to air bubbles forming on top of the paint, which would eventually result in peeling or lifting of sections of paint. In order to protect the life and structure of your vinyl roll flooring, it is best to avoid painting it altogether.

When your vinyl floor reaches the end of its lifecycle, the best – and most cost-effective way – to make it look new again, is by simply replacing it.
